The Administration shall issue an Exemption Certificate, irrespective of the date of construction of the ship concerned, in accordance with regulation I/12(a)(vii), and shall ensure that the list of cargoes the ship is permitted to carry is attached to the Exemption Certificate. 2. The ship is only permitted to carry in the exempted cargo hold(s), the cargoes noted in the Table 1 of the MSC/Circ.1395/Rev.6;
3. It is understood that the authorized cargoes will only be carried in bulk form.
4. The vessel is fitted with steel hatch covers and effective means of closing all ventilators and other openings leading to the cargo spaces.
5. For ships required the certification for carriage of dangerous goods according to Regulation 10.7.2 Chapter II-2 the exemption includes solid dangerous goods in bulk only to the extent these cargoes are covered by such certificate.
